My name is Jackee and I am coordinating a mission project for Camp Meeting. The children attending camp meeting will be packing food for a public school in the Gladstone area. 76% of the children attending **Oak Grove Elementary** fall below the federal poverty level and qualify for free or reduced lunch. They typically receive breakfast and lunch at school during the week but during the weekends and summer months, the only help that the children receive is the food sent home for the kids to prepare and eat. Typically, there are no snacks provided so the Oregon Conference Family and Children's Ministry department is asking for donations of individually wrapped snacks or monetary donations to purchase snacks. During camp meeting the children will package up snack bags for Oak Grove students to supplement their weekend food.

We are asking that you place this insert in your bulletin from July1 through July 15th or place the announcement directly in your bulletin.
